Student Development

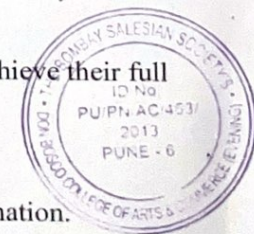
1. Support the academic and personal growth of students.
